Among other places, we will visit the Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag, Checkpoint Charlie, and the remains of the Berlin Wall. During a Berlin quiz tour you will get the opportunity to explore the city on your own, and you will also get some free time to go shopping or do sports. Depending on the weather and the interests of the group, we will explore Berlin by boat, visit one of its famous museums, or go on a tour around the town's graffiti art scene.

This course is designed to help you understand and speak the German language and know the habits and customs of Germany. This intensive German language and culture course is run by experienced and highly motivated language teachers. You will have the excellent opportunity to improve your knowledge of German according to your prior linguistic proficiency. With the help of an initial entry test we will assess your language competence and find the suitable class for you. There will be no more than 12 students in one class. Highly professional language teachers will use the latest teaching methods and up-to-date materials so that you can develop and improve your learning technique. After completing the course, you will receive a certificate which will proof your level of language proficiency. 


