## Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March

We will discover the castle district Hradčany and the picturesque streets of Nový Svět that lie within it. These beautiful districts surround the castle of Prague, which is listed as the largest ancient castle in the world in the Guinness Book of Records.



## Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> March

The city Kutná Hora is part of the UNESCO world heritage. Due to the exploitation of nearby silver mines in the 14th and 15th century, Kutná Hora became one of the richest cities of Europe, which allowed it to build prestigious monuments and churches. After already having spent several days in the „City of Gold“, you will also get to visit the so-called „City of Silver“.

The Jewish Quarter in Prague contains the most well-preserved Jewish historical monuments in Europe, among them six synagogues, the historical Jewish Town Hall and the Old Jewish Cemetery. In the evening, we are going to see a play in the famous black light theatre Metro.

After breakfast, we will head to our bus to return to Berlin, Munich or Hamburg. Once you are back with your host family, you will definitely miss the amazing experience in Prague!

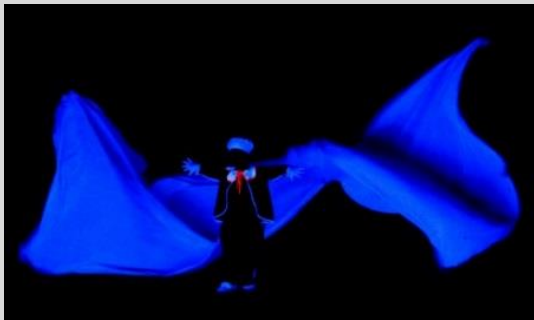

# TRANSPORT TO PRAGUE ON 24TH MARCH 2018

We offer all students three different places of departure – Hamburg, Berlin or Munich. Please let us know from which city you want to leave and when exactly you are arriving in Berlin, Hamburg or Munich. We will collect you from the train station or ZOB (bus station) in each city. The transport to Hamburg, Berlin or Munich is not included in the price.

**Berlin:** Meeting point is Berlin Südkreuz at 12.00 am. Departure of the bus to Prague is 13.15 am from the ZOB. (changes reserved!)

**Munich:** Meeting point is the central train station at 12.00 pm or the ZOB at 12.15 pm. Departure of the bus to Prague is 12.55 pm (midday) from the ZOB. (changes reserved!)

**Hamburg:** Meeting point is the central train station at 7.30 am or the ZOB at 7.45 am. Departure of the bus to Prague is 8.45 am from the ZOB. (changes reserved!)

## TRANSPORT FROM PRAGUE ON 29TH MARCH 2018

Depending on what is best for you, we will take you back to Hamburg, Berlin or Munich and make sure you can catch their connecting trains or busses back home. To do that, we need the exact details about the transport connections you plan on taking.

**Berlin:** Arrival from Prague around 13.00 or 14.00 pm in Berlin Südkreuz. The connections should be booked starting at 14.30 pm. (changes reserved!)

**Munich:** Arrival from Prague around 14.00 und 15.00 pm at the ZOB (bus station). The connections should be booked starting at 15.30 pm from the central train station or ZOB. (changes reserved!)

**Hamburg:** Arrival from Prague around 18.00 pm at the ZOB (bus station) und central train station. The connections should be booked starting at 19.00 pm from the central train station or ZOB. (changes reserved!)

## HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE IN THE TRIP?

1. Please fill out the registration form very carefully. You will need the signature of your parents and host family. The registration form contains important information, which we need because you are underage. That is why it is a bit longer than a normal online booking on the internet. 2. After we have received the money, you will be sent a confirmation of participation.
3. You will receive an exact agenda of the trip and all the relevant information (what should I pack? etc.) This information is sent to you and your host family. Should the information not reach you, please contact the aubiko office in Hamburg.
4. Please plan and book your journey to and from Munich, Hamburg or Berlin and send us your arrival and departure details.
5. Save the aubiko emergency number and check if you have sent us your correct mobile phone number.
