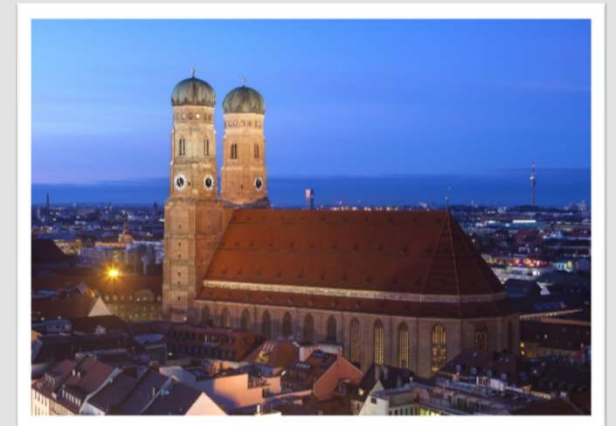

FUN IN SNOWY GARMISCH-PARTENKIRCHEN AND SIGHTSEEING IN MUNICH

Germany lies at your feet! The Zugspitze, at 2 962 meters, is the highest peak in Germany. There are three glaciers and lots of snow. You will have the most exciting view from up there. 360° of uninterrupted views over more than 400 peaks in four different countries. A view you will never forget!

After your arrival we will visit the inner city of the Bavarian Capital, Munich and its charming architecture. After a bit of sightseeing, we will enjoy the famous Bavarian cuisine. Once you've eaten here, no other German Schnitzel will ever taste as good. The next day we will take the cable car up the mountain. On this tour, you will enjoy a fascinating view of the northern part of the Alps. Up there, we will have time to visit the highest church in Germany and an an igloo village located on the glacier. Two things are guaranteed: Snow fights and walking through the snow!

Our time on Sunday morning is reserved for more sightseeing in Munich: we will see an actual surfing spot amidst the city, stroll through the Capital and buy souvenirs.

Please remember to bring warm and comfortable clothes. Also think about the right shoes: they should be comfortable and able to withstand water and snow.



AGENDA

Friday, March 1

- 2-6 pm: Arrival in Munich
- After the arrival at our hostel, we will have a sightseeing tour through the great city, where we will visit the *Sendlinger Tor*, *Viktualienmarkt*, Town Hall and the *Karlsplatz*, also called *Stachus*. That's also the location of a typical Bavarian restaurant, the *Schnitzelwirt*, where we will have dinner.

Saturday, March 2

- After a filling breakfast we will take the cable car up the mountain with a short stop at the *Eibsee*-station. With almost 3000m above sea level, we will have a fantastic view beyond the borders to Switzerland, Austria, Italy and Liechtenstein and take it all in during a short break with packed lunch.
- By taking the *Gletscherbahn*, we will get to the *Zugspitzplatt* a bit down below. Here we have time for food, sledding and a snowball fight! On top of that we will visit an igloo village hotel and to the *Maria-Heimsuchung* church which is the highest in Germany.
- Eventually, we will take the rack railway down to Garmisch-Partenkirchen and head back to Munich. Time for a laid back dinner in our hostel.

Sunday, March 3

- After breakfast at our hostel we will walk to the *Eisbach*, a popular surfing spot for people from all over the world. Besides some more sightseeing by the *Marienplatz*, and the *Alter Peter* a big church in Munich, there is a bit of free time to stroll through the town and buy souvenirs.
