











1 week in Hamburg and Berlin 22<sup>th</sup> April – 28<sup>th</sup> April 2018











Our week will start in Berlin. Berlin is a uniquely appealing and charming metropolis. Innumerable sights reflect the contemporary mind-set and *Zeitgeist* of the city, its long history up until the dramatic events of the 20th century. Among other places, we will visit the Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag, Checkpoint Charlie, and the remains of the Berlin Wall. During a Berlin quiz tour you will get the opportunity to explore the city on your own, and you will also get some free time to go shopping or do sports. Depending on the weather and the interests of the group, we will explore Berlin by boat, visit one of its famous museums, or go on a tour around the town's graffiti art scene. After three days we will go to Hamburg.

Hamburg is often called "Germany's Gateway to the World". It is the second largest city of Germany and has a lot to offer: impressive sights, an exciting history, a multicultural lifestyle, and the unique atmosphere of its harbour. We will see the harbour, the Hafen City, the town hall, the Elbphilharmonie, The Miniatur Wunderland, the area around the Alster called Jungfernstieg and of course we will climb the Michel. We will go by boat and if you want we will arrange a canoeing trip.

In Hamburg we will also visit a German School. During the school time you will meet German students in your age and your teacher will have the chance to talk with the head of school to talk about a future partnership.
