Right after your arrival we will visit the Bavarian Capital, Munich. There we will walk through the Old Town with its beautiful buildings. The next day we will take the cable car up the mountain. On this tour, you will enjoy a fascinating view of the northern part of the Alps. Depending on the time, we will visit the highest church in Germany or an igloo village located on the glacier. Two things are guaranteed: Snow fights and walking through the snow! Then, we will have fun at an indoor waterpark and at the end of this unforgettable day you will be able to enjoy the famous Bavarian cuisine. Once you've eaten here, no other German Schnitzel will ever taste as good. The next day is reserved for Munich: time to enjoy the "*English Garden*" and stroll through the Capital and buy souvenirs.

#### Friday 1<sup>st</sup>

- 16.00 pm: Arrival in Munich
- After the Arrival at our hostel, we will have a sightseeing tour through the great City, where we will visit the Town Hall, the *"Marienplatz"*, and the *"Alter Peter"* a big church in Munich from which you can see the city from above. On the top of the Church you have an amazing view over the Bavarian Capital. Afterwards you might have a little bit of free time, to stroll through the Town and buy souvenirs.
- In the evening we will walk to the "Stachus" and have dinner at the "Schnitzelwirt", a typical Bavarian restaurant.

#### Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup>

- After a filling breakfast we will take the Alpspitz-railway up the mountain to the Eibsee, 1.000 meters above sea level, where you will have fantastic views. We will have a packed lunch with us and along the way there be possibilities to rest, eat and drink.
- From there we will take the cablecar to the Zugspitze, the highest mountain in Germany with almost 3.000 meters above sea level.
- Optional Visit to the igloo village
- Optional Visit to the "Maria-Heimsuchung" church, which, at almost 3,000 meters above sea level, is the highest in Germany
- After this we will go to the Alpspitz Wellenbad Garmisch indoor waterpark
- Dinner in a Bavarian restaurant lots of Schnitzel, traditional decorations and Bavarian music

#### Sunday 3rd

 After breakfast at our hostel, we will walk to the "*Eisbach*", a popular Surfing Spot for people from all over the world. Just next to it, is the "Haus der Kunst" a museum for mordern art, where we can visit an exhibition. Another option will be the BMW world, a remarkable Museum for car design.
