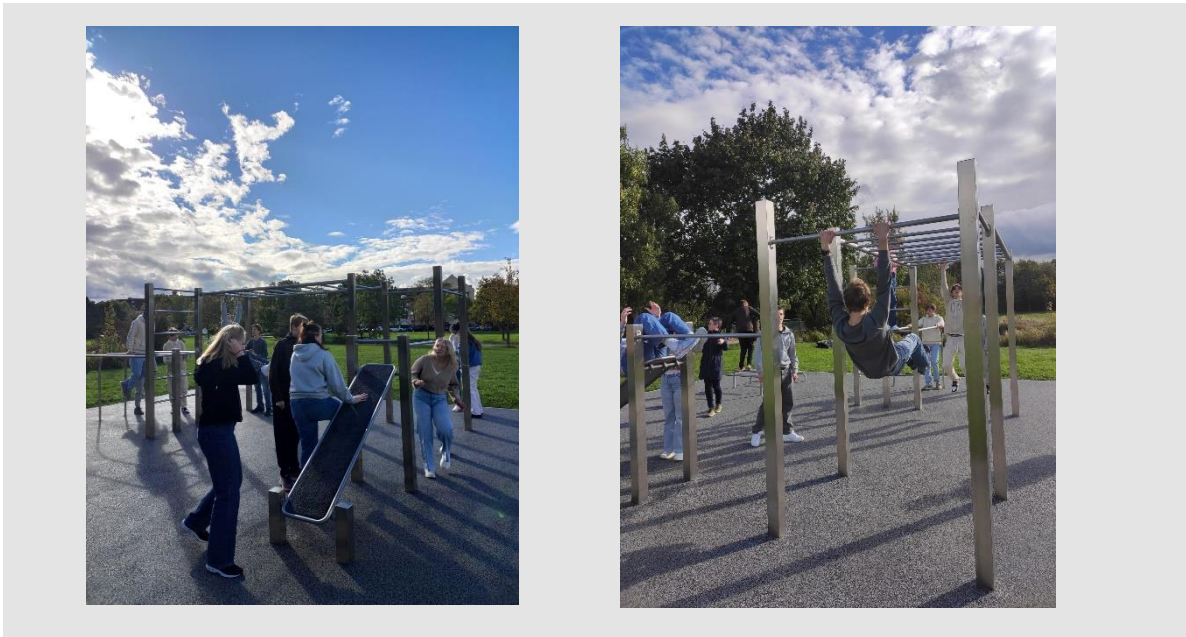


# School exchange Tyristrand -Munich

## ***Sunday, 25<sup>th</sup> of September***

In the morning, a visit to the Dachau memorial was in store. A very impressive and formative experience, which gave the guests insights into the time of National Socialism and the concentration camp during a guided tour.

Then it was time for lunch. Afterwards, sheltered from the unfortunately somewhat rainy weather, we went to SeaLife Munich, where we spent the afternoon admiring many animals and the wonders of the underwater world. After a short shopping stop in Munich's largest shopping centre, we returned to the hotel.



### ***Thursday, 29<sup>th</sup> of September***

On Thursday it was hiking day at the Carl-Orff-Gymnasium and the pupils from Tyrstrand joined the 10th classes and went bowling all together. There they had a lot of fun bowling with each other!

After lunch, they went to the Theresienwiese, where the Norwegian pupils were able to admire the Bavaria in front of the Ruhmeshalle and get a small glimpse of the Oktoberfest. It was impressive to stroll through the world's largest folk festival!

Afterwards we went to Schleißheim Palace, where we visited the Neues Schloss. It is a very impressive baroque palace with beautiful parks. For the final evening, we went to a typical Bavarian restaurant with delicious dishes from the region. A successful conclusion!
