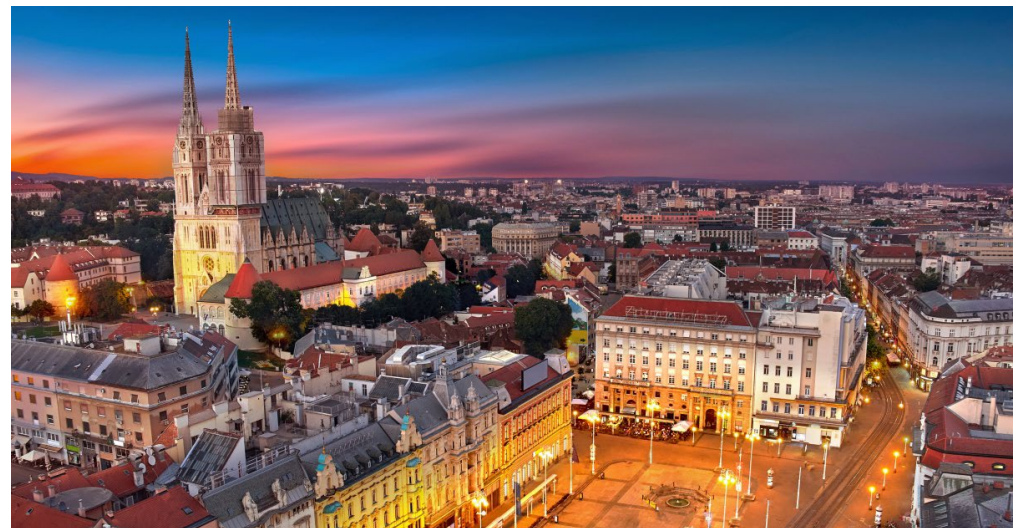
WELCOME TO BUDAPEST!
